

Town of Perry
Minutes of Town Board Meeting
Tuesday, August 9, 2005
Perry Town Hall

1. Call to order. Chairman Pat Downing called the meeting to order at 7:40 PM. Supervisors Larry Price and Roger Kittleson, Treasurer Judy Keller and Clerk Mary Price were present. Also in attendance: Mark Haebig, Ed Sutter, Dennis Orr, Susan Orr, Gary Boley, Ken Bartz, Todd Larson, Ann Windsor, Mick Klein Kennedy.
2. Minutes of Previous Meetings – July 13, 2005. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to approve the minutes of the Town Board meeting held on July 13, 2005 as prepared. Motion carried.
3. Financial Report:
 - a. Treasurer's Report, and check signing options; Treasurer Judy Keller presented the monthly report and reported that the highway aids and shared revenues were received. She explained the bank's options available for check signing. Supervisor Price indicated that municipalities' check signing protocol might be set by state statute. He will research and report the requirements.
 - b. Pay Bills due. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to pay the bills as approved. Motion carried.
4. WiDOT – Daleyville report; speed boards. Supervisor Roger Kittleson reported that the Village of Blanchardville is not willing to rent its speed board to other municipalities. Chairman Pat Downing reported that he received a letter from WiDOT in response to the Town's requests for Daleyville. The letter indicated that the WiDOT:
 - a. will not install "Children At Play" signs since "it is standard sign that the Department installs and the Federal Highway Administration does not endorse the use of these signs."
 - b. would reconsider extending the 30 mph speed limit beyond "the end of the developed community and at the beginning of the rural area...if future development happens at these locations."
 - c. will move the "Reduced Speed Ahead" sign closer to the actual 30 mph speed zone.
 - d. 3-way stop at State Highway 78 and County Highway A intersection is not justified.
 - e. will add a double yellow no passing zone throughout Daleyville and several hundred feet north of Daleyville.
5. Land Use:
 - a. Permits – Tim and Mark Keller, ag. bldg. addition. The Board reviewed Mark and Tim Keller's application for an addition to an ag. bldg. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to approve the application. Motion carried.
 - b. Dennis Orr, 195 CTH JG, ag. accessory bldg. Land Use Committee Chairman Mick Klein Kennedy presented the Committee's report and recommendation that the Town Board approve the amended building permit application to site the ag. accessory building west of the existing house at Site 2. Roger Kittleson moved and Larry Price seconded a motion to approve Dennis Orr's application for an

- ag. accessory building at Site 1. The Board reviewed the Land Use Committee's discussion and recommendation. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to amend the main motion to add approval of Site 2. Motion carried. The Board discussed views and vistas. Main motion carried. The Town Board will meet with the Land Use Committee on Sept. 6, 2005 to consider Site 1.
- c. Gerald Larson, ag. accessory bldg. – approx. 300 Tyvand Rd. Land Use Committee Chairman Mick Klein Kennedy presented the Committee's report. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to deny Gerald Larson's ag. accessory building permit application. The Board reviewed the Land Use Committee's actions and discussions, and the Land Use Plan's Section 6 Mandatory Criteria 4 and 7. Motion carried. Todd Larson, agent, requested additional information, clarification of procedures and submitted an alternate site that will be considered in September.
- d. Sunset Ave. progress report. Clerk Mary Price presented the Sunset Avenue inspection report received from Strand Engineers.
- e. Reports from Brian Bruenig, Dane Co. Zoning re: violations. Clerk Mary Price presented information received from Brian Breunig, Dane Co. Zoning Inspector. Additional information will be presented in September.
7. Mt. Horeb Fire District report. Representative Ed Sutter presented the District's report and indicated that the District is discussing the possibility of a full-time Chief, and will apply for a grant to subsidize the EMS secretary's salary.
8. Parks and Open Space Commission. Commission Chairman Mick Klein Kennedy presented the Commission's report and recommendations. The Board reviewed the Commission's proposed letter to residents explaining the Rustic Road program. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to approve the letter to be sent to residents for the Rustic Road program. Motion carried. The Board reviewed the revised Rules and Regulations for Perry parks. Gary Boley reported that the Friends of Perry Parks received grants to purchase seeds.
9. Roads, Equipment, Facilities. The Board reviewed WI statutes for Town roads and Indian Hill Road. The Board reviewed reports from the patrolman on wedging, overlays and scheduling the Tyvand Rd. guardrail project, culverts and salt/sand content.
10. Dane County Towns Association report. Pat Downing presented information received at the Dane Co. Towns Assn. Executive Board meetings.
11. Announcements. The Board reviewed reports received and the Town's website updates.
12. Adjournment. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to adjourn. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 11:05 PM.
