Minutes of the Town Board Meeting

Saturday, May 7, 2005

1. **Call to order.** Chairman Pat Downing called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM at the Perry Town Garage.
2. **Attendance.** Others present were Supervisors Roger Kittleson and Larry Price, and Town Patrolman Fritz Mani.
3. **Inspection of Town Garage and Equipment.** The Board and the Patrolman inspected the Town Garage and the Town's road equipment. The Board commented that the shop was in excellent condition as was the equipment. Chairman Pat Downing commended Fritz Mani on the way he has improved the appearance of the shop and the way he has maintained the Town's equipment.
4. **Road Tour.** The Board and the Patrolman then drove around the Township to inspect several of the Town roads for the purpose of determining their condition and setting priorities for repairs for 2005.
5. **Advertising for Bids.** Roger moved and Larry seconded a motion to obtain bids for the following projects:

The Board requested that the Town Clerk advertise for bids for these projects and place a deadline for submission of bids as the date of the May 24, 2005 Town Board meeting. The Board also requested that the Clerk mail letters to those contractors who have requested to be on the list of contractors contacted for bids for road repairs.

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6. **Repair Projects.** The Board identified various repair projects for 2005. Most of the projects identified were areas that needed road patch or grading of shoulders to allow better water drainage from the road surface. The Board complimented the Patrolman on the repair and improvement projects that he had completed in 2004 and early 2005.
7. **Adjourn.** Roger moved and Larry seconded a motion to adjourn. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 1:45 PM.
