

Town of Perry
Minutes of Town Board Meeting
Tuesday, March 14, 2006
Perry Town Hall

1. Call to order. Chairman Pat Downing called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM. Supervisors Larry Price and Roger Kittleson, Treasurer Judy Keller and Clerk Mary Price were present. Also in attendance: Gary Boley, Mark Haebig, Craig Bluschke, and Steve Maessick.
2. Minutes of Previous Meetings – February 14, 2006. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to approve the minutes of the February 14, 2006 Town Board meeting as published. Motion carried.
3. Financial Report:
 - a. Treasurer's Report. Treasurer Judy Keller presented the Treasurer's report for the month of February, 2006.
 - b. Pay Bills due. The Board reviewed the invoices presented for payment. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to approve a contract with the Co-op of Blanchardville for 750 gals. of diesel fuel at the current rate. Motion carried. Roger Kittleson moved and Larry Price seconded a motion to pay the bills. Motion carried.
4. Comments by Town residents. Discussion included questions on voting equipment and other equipment for the Town Hall.
5. Land Use:
 - a. Permit for ag. accessory bldg. addition. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to approve the building permit application for an addition to an existing ag. accessory building as presented by Steve Maessick. Motion carried.
 - b. Dane County Ordinance Amendment No. 23 – amending Chapter 34, Dane Co. Code, Controlled Blasting Site Areas. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to disapprove Dane County Ordinance Amendment No. 23 – amending Chapter 34, Dane Co. Code, Controlled Blasting Site Areas. Motion carried.
 - c. Dane County Ordinance Amendment No. 26 – amending Chapter 10, Dane Co. Code, Transfer of Development Rights Zoning District. Larry Price reported discussions and information presented at the Dane Co. Board of Supervisors Committee of the Whole meeting held on March 9, 2006. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to postpone action on Dane County Ordinance Amendment No. 26 – amending Chapter 10, Dane Co. Code, Transfer of Development Rights Zoning District to the May, 2006 Town Board meeting. Motion carried.
 - d. Dane County Ordinance Amendment No. 27 – amending Chapter 10, Dane Co. Code, Permitted Uses in C-1 and C-2 Commercial Districts. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to approve Dane County

6. Historic Commission – report. Clerk Mary Price presented a report received from Darren Walker, Chair - Commission members Linda Bluschke and Darren Walker attended a grant opportunities meeting at the State Historical Society on Feb. 17, 2006; the Commission approved two responses to the application for a Certificate of Appropriateness for the Hauge Log Church Historic District and the written responses will be published in March, 2006.
7. Parks and Open Space – report and recommendations, Hauge Park Plan. Clerk Mary Price reported that Mick Klein Kennedy, Chair, could not attend and a report will be presented in April, 2006.
8. Town of Perry website – report. Chairman Pat Downing announced that Craig Bluschke volunteered to maintain the Town’s website. The Board expressed their appreciation for this service. Clerk Mary Price and Craig Bluschke reported updates and changes to the website and future plans.
9. Roads, Equipment, Facilities – Reports; retirement plans; set Road Tour date. Larry Price reported information received from the State Bank of Cross Plains concerning the Simple IRA options. Larry Price moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to increase the Patrolman’s salary by 2% (to \$18.36 per hour); match the Patrolman’s 3% contribution to the Town’s Simple IRA; contribute 5% of the Patrolman’s salary paid Jan. – March, 2006 to his retirement plan. Motion carried.
The Board will conduct the annual Road Tour on Saturday, April 15, 2006.
10. Dane County Towns Association report. Pat Downing reported that the Dane Co. Towns Association will present a resolution to the Governor to create a Capital area planning commission.
11. Announcements. The Board reviewed upcoming meetings.
12. Adjournment. Roger Kittleson moved and Larry Price seconded a motion to adjourn. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 10:30 PM.
