Speed Limits on Town Roads

1. Call to order. Chairman Pat Downing called the public hearing to order at 8:05 PM. Supervisors Roger Kittleson and Mick Klein Kennedy and Clerk Mary Price were present. Also in attendance: Linda Bluschke, Craig Bluschke, Alice Yeager, Margaret Berg, Ken Bartz, Richard Keller, Alice Zander, Ray Zander, Sonja Luetschwager, Gerhard Luetschwager, Brad Grundahl, Karen Grundahl, Terry Miller, Carol Watkins, Kent Haroldson, Erin Haroldson, Ann Windsor, David Mays, Ken Johnson, Tom Stoehr, Ed Sutter.
2. Land Use Committee Ordinance. Supervisor Mick Klein Kennedy and Clerk Mary Price presented background information and reported the review and amendments proposed by the Town's attorney Mark Rooney. Recommended changes:
 - a. add Removal clause – per WI 2005 ACT 207/AB 904 and
 - b. add method to advertise Vacancies.
 - c. clarify or reconcile Section 4 and Section 5 – method used to appoint Committee Chairperson.
3. Recycling Ordinance. Recommended changes:
 - a. Section 1.23 correction - (*Example: 8 feet long x 4 feet wide x 4 feet high = 5 cubic yards*)
 - b. Section 1.22 – add “household” to “All solid waste....”
 - c. Section 1.23 – add “household” to “All solid waste....”
4. Citations Ordinance. Recommended changes:
 - a. Section 1.08 – “affect” should be “effect”
 - b. Section 1.08 – clarify when Ordinance takes effect.
5. Historic Preservation Ordinance. Recommended changes – none.

6. Outdoor Burning Ordinance. Many attendees commented and offered suggested changes. Recommended changes:
 - a. Section 4 – renumber sub-sections.
 - b. Section 4.1 – define “small outdoor fire”
 - c. Section 7.1 – “nuisance free” should be deleted.
 - d. Section 7.2 – “Except for barbecue, gas and charcoal grills,” should be deleted.
 - e. Section 7.4 – “agricultural” should be “rural”
 - f. Section 8.4 or 8. 6 – Variance method should be added.
 - g. Section 8.5 – allow replacement or disallow existing outdoor furnaces.
 - h. Section 11.0 – “representative” should be more restrictive.
 - i. Section 14 – clarify effective date.

7. Dark Sky Lighting Ordinance. Many attendees commented on the proposed ordinance. Recommendations:
 - a. Section 9.2 – “required” should be “encouraged”.
 - b. Section 10 – variance process for historic restoration should be added.
 - c. Section 11 – clarify effective date.
 - d. Refer to committee to develop educational and source materials.

8. Speed Limits on Town Roads. Chairman Pat Downing explained state statutes regulating speed limits on Town roads. No changes were recommended.
