

Recyling Ordinance Amended April 14, 2008

- All solid household waste brought to the Center shall be contained in <u>clear plastic bags.</u>
- All solid household waste brought to the Center shall be limited to five (5) cubic yards per week. (Example: 8 feet long x 4 feet wide x 4 feet high = 5 cubic yds)

<u>Recyclable Materials</u>

- Aluminum, steel and bi-metal cans: clean, rinse, and flatten if possible for space savings.
- Glass containers: clean, rinse, and remove rings and caps.
- Rigid plastic containers made of PETE and HDPE and coded with "1" or "2" on the bottom of the container: clean, rinse and flatten if possible for space savings.
- Corrugated cardboard: flatten.
- Office paper, computer printouts, shiny/coated, carbonless, onion skin, fax, post-it notes, notebook, envelopes, window envelopes, magazines and similar paper, catalogs, flyers, etc: bundle and tie or place in paper bag
- Newspaper: bundle and tie.
- Waste tires: May be brought to the Recycling Center on the first Saturday of May and first Saturday of November. Tires should be removed from their rims. A disposal fee will be charged. Tires may also be taken to a retailer who sells tires.
