2. Donna Vogel, Dane Co. Deputy Treasurer, explained the WI statutes and requirements to process tax bills; procedure and deadline to prepay taxes; escrow notifications; due dates and penalties for school payments; consequences if no levy is adopted by the electors.
3. Atty. Mark Hazelbaker explained his background and experience in municipal law and the Dane Co. Towns Association. Atty. Hazelbaker presented legal mandates in WI Chapter 60 statutes requiring Towns to provide fire protection and other services and the Town's liability if no levy is adopted by the electors.

Atty. Hazelbaker discussed options available in open records requests; requirements and effects of an audit; cross deputization options and requirements by Clerk and Treasurer.

4. Pat Downing moved and Merel Black seconded a motion to adopt the 2015 Town tax levy, to be paid in 2016 pursuant to Section 60.10(1)(a) of Wis. Statutes - \$ 309,724.00. Yes – 82; No – 3; Abstain – 0; Motion carried.
5. Adjourn. Larry Price moved and Gerhard Luetschwager seconded a motion to adjourn. Motion carried on voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 8:40 PM.
