Fire Safety Inspections and Enforcement Ordinance

- 1.1 AUTHORITY.** The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Perry, Dane County, Wisconsin hereby elects to adopt this ordinance by its adoption of village powers under sec. 60.10(2)(c), 60.22(3) and 61.34(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
- 1.2 PURPOSE.** The purpose of this ordinance is to promote the general health, safety and welfare and to in accordance with the Fire Protection and Rescue Service Agreement with the Mount Horeb Area Fire Department.
- 1.3 SCOPE.** The scope of this ordinance includes enforcement of the Fire Protection and Rescue Service Agreement with the Mount Horeb Area Fire Department, in its current form and as it may be amended from time to time in the future.
- Fire Protection in the area within the Town served by the Mount Horeb Area Fire Department shall be furnished in accordance with the Fire Protection and Rescue Service Agreement with the Mount Horeb Area Fire Department. The Chief of the Mount Horeb Area Fire Department shall hold the office of Fire Inspector, pursuant to Wis. Stat. Sec. 101.14 and may appoint one or more deputy fire inspectors.
- 1.4 CITATIONS.** Official authorized to issue citations. Citations authorized by this Ordinance may be issued by the Fire Inspector or Deputy Fire Inspectors as defined above. The officials granted authority to issue citations under this section may delegate that authority to other Town employees but only with the prior approval of the Town Board.
- A warning citation shall be issued when a violation is found, followed by an additional inspection after 30 days. The violation will then be subject to a forfeiture citation.
- 1.5 SEVERABILITY.** The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable, and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
- 1.6 EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as provided by law.
