MINUTES OF TOWN BOARD MEETING

Tuesday April 23, 2013

8:00 AM Town Garage

1. Roger Kittleson called meeting to order at 8:00 AM. Attendance: Roger Kittleson, Ken Hefty, Mick Klein Kennedy and Fritz Mani
2. Inspect shop and equipment with Fritz Mani.
3. Tour the Town Roads to determine maintenance priorities.
4. Discuss Bridges to be repaired

Road Tour looked at the following roads for possible repair.

Overlay Work:

Spring Valley Road: Discussion here was about doing an overlay of 2" for a distance of one half mile. This project would be better suited to a TRIP grant, so discussed putting this project off until next year (2014) when we would be able to apply for a TRIP grant.

Seal Coat Work:

East Perry Center Road: Discussion here was about single seal coat for a distance of 1.5 miles from the intersection of Spring Valley road to hwy JG.

Albert Haag Road. Discussion here was about .19 mile of single seal coat.

Sutter Lane: Discussion here was about .30 mile of single seal coat.

Crack Filling Work:

Lee Valley Road: Discussion here was about crack filling from Tyvand road to the west on blacktop overlay areas.

Kittleson Road: Discussion here was about crack filling on overlay done in 2012, by bridge

Salt shed: Discussion here was about crack filling at shed apron

Culvert work: Discussion here was on the possible need for culverts on Kittleson road.

Discussion took place reviewing the Town policy was for culverts at field roads. It was agreed that the first culvert is the landowner's responsibility and then it is the town responsibility for the second culvert. Do we need something in writing on this?

Bridges: Discussion here was to review the Summary of Recommendations for Town of Perry bridges, on Kittleson Road, Drammen Valley Road and Lee Valley Road. The following recommendations were discussed for these bridges

Kittleson Road bridge: 1) Wedge Approaches- had overlay installed in 2012
2) Remove Brush from around and under Bridge-Fritz will take care of

Drammen Valley Road: 1) Replace Structure, discussion was on submitting an application for bridge replacement to the Dane County 2013-2018 Bridge Replacement/ Rehabilitation Program.

Lee Valley Road: 1) Seal the cracks in the asphalt overlay 2) Wedge Approaches, 3) Check tightness of the spreader beam bolts.

Salt shed: Discussion here was how to address the cracks in the apron that have the Town out of compliance with Wisconsin Administrative code TRANS277. The cracks are classified as a moderate defect, and can be corrected with crack filling. Discussion continued with a decision to get a bid on filling these cracks with our other road bid items. **(See above under Crack Filling Work)**

Cold Patch: Fritz would like to get approval for four loads of cold patch at @\$600.00 per load.

The Board and the Patrolman inspected the Town Garage and the Town's road equipment. The Board commented that the shop was in excellent condition as was the equipment. The Board commended Fritz Mani on the way he continues to maintain the organization of the shop and the way he has maintained the Town's equipment and roads.

Adjourn. Mick Klein Kennedy moved and Ken Hefty seconded a motion to adjourn. **Motion carried.** 3-0 The Meeting adjourned at 11.00 AM.
