

Town of Perry
Minutes of Town Board Meeting
Tuesday, June 10, 2008
Perry Town Hall

1. Call to order. Chairman Pat Downing called the meeting to order at 7:35 PM. Supervisors Roger Kittleson and Mick Klein Kennedy, Treasurer Judy Keller and Clerk Mary Price were present. Also in attendance: Sheriff Dave Mahoney, Christine Milovani, Linda Bluschke, Mark Haebig, Ken Bartz, Alice Yaeger, Margaret Berg, Dep. Scott Lehman, Brent Radke, Gary Boley, Troy Thompson.
2. Minutes of Previous Meetings – May 13, 2008. The Board discussed amendments to the May 13, 2008 minutes. Mick Klein Kennedy moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to approve the minutes of the Town Board meeting held on May 13, 2008 as amended. Motion carried.
3. Financial Report:
 - a. Treasurer's Report. Judy Keller presented the monthly Treasurer's report.
 - b. Pay Bills due. The Board reviewed the invoices presented for payment. Roger Kittleson moved and Mick Klein Kennedy seconded a motion to pay the approved bills. Motion carried.
4. Dane Co. Sheriff Dave Mahoney. Dane Co. Sheriff Dave Mahoney presented information and clarifications concerning speed boards, Dane Co. Traffic Team, OWI enforcement, West Precinct location, local policing programs, contract policing, Dane Co. 911 operations, etc.
5. Comments by Town residents. Linda Bluschke requested information for publishing committee agendas. Ken Bartz asked if gutters will be installed on the Town Hall. Christine Molivani requested additional speed limit signs at Daleyville.
6. Land Use:
 - a. Eric Schloesser, approx. 1360 Keller Rd., 2 access. bldgs. Mick Klein Kennedy moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to approve building permit applications for two accessory buildings as presented by Eric Schloesser. Motion carried.
 - b. Brent Radke, 10626 Lee Valley Rd, convert barn to residence. Brent Radke requested clarifications of the Land Use Plan and application process. Mick Klein Kennedy moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to postpone action on the application presented by Brent Radke. Motion carried.
 - c. Response to American Transmission Co. proposed routes. The Board reviewed a request from the Town of Dunkirk to support the northern route proposed by American Transmission Co. Pat Downing moved and Mick Klein Kennedy seconded a motion to support the Town of Dunkirk's request and inform the Public Service Commission that the northern route proposed by American Transmission Co. is preferable. Motion carried.

7. Rural Numbering Ordinance. The Board reviewed the proposed Rural Numbering Ordinance.
8. Cell Tower Ordinance – Town of Dunn model ordinance. The Board reviewed the Town of Dunn model ordinance and the Dane Co. ordinance regulating communications towers. Mick Klein Kennedy moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to direct the Land Use Committee to review, develop potential revisions and recommendations and hold a public hearing to consider a Town of Perry ordinance to regulate communications towers, and schedule a public hearing prior to convening the Town Board meeting on July 10, 2008 . Motion carried.
9. Outdoor and Refuse Burning Ordinance – possible violation. The Board reviewed a complaint received. Roger Kittleson moved and Mick Klein Kennedy seconded a motion to direct the Clerk to send a warning notice to Ken Ruegsegger, 75 York Valley Rd., describing a possible violation of the Outdoor and Refuse Burning Ordinance. Motion carried.
10. Committee reports and appointments:
 - a. Appointments – Weed Commissioner; Historic Preservation; Parks and Open Space Committee. Chairman Pat Downing presented appointment recommendations. Mick Klein Kennedy moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to approve the appointment of Joe Hoff to serve as the Weed Commissioner for another two year term. Motion carried. Mick Klein Kennedy moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to approve the appointment of Ernie Grinder to another three year term on the Historic Preservation Commission. Motion carried. Roger Kittleson moved and Mick Klein Kennedy seconded a motion to approve the appointment of Phoebe Blackman to another three year term on the Parks and Open Space Committee. Motion carried.
 - b. Parks and Open Space report and recommendations – Hauge Log Church Historic District Park field road. Gary Boley, Parks and Open Space Committee Chair, presented the Committee’s report and recommendations.
11. Roads, Equipment, Facilities – reports; 2008 road repairs – open bids. Chairman Pat Downing opened crack filling and sealcoating bids submitted by Crack Filling Service, T. A. Z. Crackfilling, Bartelt Enterprises, Dane Co. Hwy. Dept., Scott Construction and Fahrner Construction.
12. Announcements. Clerk Mary Price reported Dane Co. notices received.
13. Adjournment. Mick Klein Kennedy moved and Roger Kittleson seconded a motion to adjourn. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 11:12 PM.
