Minutes of Town Board Meeting  
Monday, January 23, 2017  
Perry Town Hall, 10084 CTH A

1. Call to order. Chairman Roger Kittleson called the meeting to order at 7:35PM. Supervisors Ken Hefty and Mick Klein Kennedy, Treasurer Stephanie Zwettler and Clerk Mary Price were present. Also in attendance: Royce Nelson and Doug Nelson.
  
2. Roads, Equipment, Facilities:
  - a. Truck and tractor bids – award contracts; approve loan terms. The Board reviewed information presented by Supervisors Ken Hefty and Mick Klein Kennedy and Patrolman Royce Nelson.

Ken Hefty moved and Mick Klein Kennedy seconded a motion to purchase a Freightliner 114SD Tandem Axle Truck with options from Truck Country of Wisconsin, Inc. as proposed – net \$59,105.02, with Sterling truck trade-in. Motion carried.

Ken Hefty moved and Mick Klein Kennedy seconded a motion to purchase truck equipment with option for new Freightliner truck as proposed - \$59,286.00 from Madison Truck Equipment, Inc., as proposed. Motion carried.

Mick Klein Kennedy moved and Ken Hefty seconded a motion to purchase a Massey Ferguson 6615 Dyna-VT tractor with loader and bucket from McFarlane Mfg. Co., Inc. as proposed – net \$46,500.00, with tractor trade-in. Motion carried.
  
  - b. Salt/sand – additional supplies. Patrolman Royce Nelson reported salt usage to date. The Board reviewed salt options and past years' usage.

The Board reviewed WI regulations to provide plowing services to residents for emergencies only. Ken Hefty moved and Mick Klein Kennedy seconded a motion to authorize plowing services to residents for emergencies only and change the billing rates to \$50.00/ ½ hour and \$80.00/hr. Motion carried.
  
  - c. Cell phone and internet service report. Clerk Mary Price presented information received from US Cellular and Mt. Horeb Telephone Co. Ken Hefty moved and Mick Klein Kennedy seconded a motion to provide Mt. Horeb Telephone Co. internet access service at the Town garage. Motion carried.
  
3. Historic Preservation Commission – authorize attorney. Commission Chairman Doug Nelson presented an update on the Historic Preservation Commission's work. Ken Hefty moved and Mick Klein Kennedy seconded a motion to

approve guidance from the Town's attorney(s) within the approved 2017 budget. Motion carried.

4. Adjournment. Ken Hefty moved and Mick Klein Kennedy seconded a motion to adjourn. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 11:10 PM.
