DRAFT MINUTES OF TOWN BOARD MEETING

Saturday May 9, 2009

1. Pat Downing Called meeting to order at 9:00 AM. Attendance: Pat Downing, Roger Kittleson, Fritz Mani, and Mick Klein Kennedy
2. Inspect shop and equipment with Fritz Mani.
3. Tour the Town Roads to determine maintenance priorities.

Motion: Roger Kittleson moved and Mick Klein Kennedy seconded a motion to obtain road repair bids for:

Seal coat and crack filling:

Haag Road .23 mile seal coat

Sutter lane seal coat .30 mi., or do nothing?

Looked at crack filling on Spring Valley (comments)

Albert Haag Road .19 mi. seal coat (12' wide)

Josephson Road .25 mi. patch, seal coat (include turn-a-round)

Dead End Road .61 mi. seal coat

Jacobson Road, .40 mi. seal coat

Lee Valley Road, overlay at new culvert extensions

Lee Valley Road, crack fill west end to town line

Drammen Valley road finish crack filling to Town Line

Recycling center-Daley Road .16 mi. seal coat and recycled blacktop on lower part

Sherven Road .22 mi. seal coat

Eichorst culvert on Perry Center Road, add 2' x 6' end and band to culvert, (Fritz will handle, material cost @\$80.00)

Discussion on possible Trip fund work as summarized below.

Trip fund work:

Spring Valley Road- The ridge plus small culvert

Sherven Homestead Road- Overlay

Lee valley complete overlay (fill in the gaps from last overlay)

As stated earlier, the Board and the Patrolman inspected the Town Garage and the Town's road equipment. The Board commented that the shop was in excellent condition as was the equipment. The Board commended Fritz Mani on the way he continues to maintain the organization of the shop and the way he has maintained the Town's equipment and roads.

Repair Projects: The Board identified various repair projects for 2009. Most of the projects identified were areas that needed road patch or grading of shoulders to allow better water drainage from the road surface including Jeglum Road, correct ditch, have contractor clean up nasty recycled black top work, seed and mulch.
