

Minutes of Public Hearing  
Town of Perry  
Tuesday, June 3, 2014  
Perry Town Hall

1. Call to order: Land Use Committee Chair Dean Vogel called the public hearing to order at 8:05 PM. Committee members Ann Windsor and Ken Hefty, and Clerk Mary Price were present. Also in attendance: Bob Sherven.

2. Building Ordinance amendment - Swimming Pools – was reviewed.

“Section 1.04 (3) Swimming Pools. Inground Pool - A private or residential swimming pool is a permanent structure containing a body of water in a receptacle or other container used or intended to be used solely by the owner, operator, or lessee thereof and his family, and by friends invited to use it, and includes all structural facilities, appliances and appurtenances, equipment and other items used and intended to be used for the operation and maintenance of a private or residential swimming pool.

Exempt Pool: Storable above-ground pool, not permanently affixed to the ground, which are so constructed that they may be readily disassembled for storage and reassembled to their original integrity are exempt from the provisions of this section.”

No further amendments were proposed.

3. Adjourn. Ann Windsor moved and Ken Hefty seconded a motion to adjourn the public hearing. Motion carried. The public hearing was adjourned at 8:15 PM.
