- Call to order. Chairman Roger Kittleson called the hearing to order at 7:35PM. - 2. Pledge of Allegiance. Chairman Roger Kittleson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moment of Silence. Chairman Roger Kittleson requested a Moment of Silence in remembrance of victims of September 11, 2001.

3. Comments – Rustic Road criteria, requirements, petition.

Doug Nelson presented a petition signed by 14 Town residents requesting Rustic Road designation on Lee Valley Road.

Comments in support of the designation included: to reduce speeding due to commuter use; to become eligible for Dane Co. Sheriff's Dept. enforcement.

Paula Stanton presented a statement in opposition, citing increased use by tour groups, bicycle clubs, car clubs, etc.

Laura Morland presented concerns about unintended consequences – increased traffic.

Kathy and Bill Smith presented a petition signed by 28 Town residents opposed to Rustic Road designation on Lee Valley Road.

Comments in opposition to the designation included: increased auto, bicycle, motorcycle, tour bus traffic; Lee Valley Road does not meet the Rustic Road criteria.

Ken Bartz presented information published by WI DOT – Statewide Speed Management Guidelines, and recommended a speed study.

Royce Nelson, Patrolman, reported additional signs have been installed.

Temporary speed bumps were suggested.
