Minutes of Public Hearing
Lee Valley Rd. Rustic Road designation
Thursday, November 15, 2018
Perry Town Hall

1. Call to order. Chairman Roger Kittleson called the public hearing to order at 7:35PM. Supervisors Ken Hefty and Mick Klein Kennedy, Treasurer/Deputy Clerk Stephanie Zwettler and Clerk Mary Price were present. Also in attendance: Ed Sutter, Royce Nelson, Pam Dunphy, Bill Smith, Kathy Smith, Linda Bluschke, Margaret Berg, Ken Bartz, Vicky Bartz, Susan Kiry, Tracy Morland.

Pledge of Allegiance. Chairman Kittleson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Dane Co. Dept. of Public Works, Highway and Transportation Deputy Commissioner Pam Dunphy presented speed limit information – a speed study with counters is required to determine the 85 percentile, the national standard to set speed limits. The speed study can be performed by Dane Co. Highway Dept. and billed to the Town, est. \$500.00 – 1,000.00. When the recommended speed limit is determined, signs can be posted intermittently on the road. Approximately 12 signs would be needed for Lee Valley Road @ est. \$65.00 each.
3. Comments – Rustic Road criteria, requirements. Ed Sutter commented about potentially increased traffic if the Lee Valley Road is designated as a Rustic Road. Kathy Smith opined that 45 mph speed limit is too high for Lee Valley Road traversed by farm machinery. Comments included concerns about tour buses, motorcycle clubs, car clubs, and tourists using Rustic Roads.
4. Adjourn. Ken Bartz moved and Ed Sutter seconded a motion to adjourn the public hearing. Motion carried. The public hearing adjourned at 7:50 PM.
