

Town of Perry
Minutes of Town Board Meeting- Road Tour
Thursday, March 21, 2019
Town Garage

1. Call to order. Chairman Roger Kittleson called the meeting to order at 8:00AM. Supervisors Ken Hefty and Mick Klein Kennedy and Patrolman Royce Nelson were present.

2. Review Town equipment and facilities.

The Town Garage was reviewed and inspected, and the shop was in good shape, and everything looked orderly. Royce prepared a summary sheet of items to review by the Town Board

Equipment was reviewed, and there was discussion of the future maintenance needs of each piece of equipment.

Maintenance priorities on all buildings were discussed.

3. Tour the Town Roads.

The road tour included all Town roads.

Rip-rap installation locations were discussed and include the following locations:

- Tyvand Road on the south end
- Drammen Valley Road by the apple orchard
- Spring Valley by the first hill from Hwy 78, on the north side of the road

Soil pile dumped off Sutter Road by Town of Blue Mounds on Town of Perry R.O.W. was discussed, Mick will contact Town of Blue Mounds about seeding it down.

4. Determine roads to be repaired in 2019.

Possible Road for Seal coat in 2019:

- Docken Road (already have bid from Scotts)
- Boley Road
- Jenson Road
- Clay Hill road
- River Forks Road -wait to do once Drammen Valley bridge is done, and then also do Drammen Valley road as well.
- Savanna Road possible in 2019, but more likely in 2020
- Sandy Rock Road

Determine roads to be repaired in 2019 continued:

Culverts for possible work in 2019:

- Sutter Road by Dean Sutter
- Spring Valley Road by Church road (Priority in 2019)
- Spring Valley Road by Fire number 10037 (Priority in 2019)
- Spring Valley Road 800 feet south of Spring Valley Road and Sutter Road intersection
- Drammen Valley Road 200 feet south of fire number 783
- Clay Hill Road at fire number 10940
- Dead End Road at Mt. Horeb Truck Parts.

5. Determine bridges to be repaired in 2019.

- No bridges to be repaired in 2019
- Discussion took place on the status of the Drammen Valley Road Bridge
- Discussion took place on the status of the Perry Center Road Bridge
- Strand and Associates is planning on setting up a presentation to the Town board on the Drammen Valley Road Bridge.

6. Review and determine Town road signs to be replaced in 2019.

The following roads were discussed as priorities as we start the restoration of Road Signs and stop signs.

- Dead End Road- New road name sign
- Sherven Homestead Drive- New road name sign and stop sign
- Lee Valley Road and North Hay Hollow-New road name sign and stop sign
- Sandy Rock Road at Hwy A-New road name sign
- Jenson Road at Hwy A-New road name sign
- Truman Road-New stop sign
- Duffy Road-New stop sign

7. Adjourn. Ken Hefty moved, and Mick Klein Kennedy seconded a motion to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 11:35AM
