NUTRITION MANAGER'S NOTE:

Farmer's Market Vouchers will be distributed on Friday, June 7 from 9:30 –11:00 am.. They will be distributed on a first come/first serve basis for those age 60+, who have a gross income of \$23,170.00/year or \$1,926.00/month for one person or \$31,284.00/year or \$2,607.00/month for two people. One set of vouchers is distributed per household. These vouchers can be used to purchase vegetables, fruits and herbs from Farmer's Market vendors all over Dane County. The Farmer's Market in Mt. Horeb is located on Main Street (on the lawn of the Evangelical Lutheran Church) every Thursday, from 3:00-6:00 pm, from April through mid October. Visit a Farmer's Market to meet new people, get fresh produce and get your walking in.

Meal items to be served with this: WW bread/butter, tropical fruit, chocolate cake


Week 4 - 6/28

DIRECTOR'S NOTE:

Effective November 1, 2018, air conditioning surcharges that are paid by FoodShare members in addition to rent or other shelter costs are considered a utility expense. Previously, air conditioning surcharges did not count as a utility expense. Air conditioning surcharges are typically billed to residents in public housing. FoodShare members who pay an air conditioning surcharge should contact SW Dane Outreach to get credit for this expense. Members may have to provide proof of the surcharge . FoodShare members should report all of their utility expenses when applying or renewing their benefits.

The Mt. Horeb Police Dept. now has a "Drop Box" for prescription medications, ointments and patches, vitamins, over the counter medications, and pet medications. The hours are from 8:00 am— 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. NO NEEDLES, SHARPS, EPI PENS, INHALERS OR THERMOMETERS. Plastic bags will be provided..

CASE MANAGER'S NOTE:

The Mt. Horeb Senior Center will be hosting a "Medication Review" on June 18, from 9:00 am-3:00 pm in coordination with United Way of Dane County and the Pharmacy Society of WI. This service was provided to 185 seniors in Dane County in 2018. This review is to provide counseling from registered pharmacists and a review of senior's medications in order to prevent falls. (Falls are the leading cause of injury-related deaths for WI seniors in the nation.) Do you take three or more medications, including over the counter? Have you experienced unexplained dizziness? Have you fallen in the past year? If you have answered yes to any of these questions, you may benefit in attending this program. The pharmacists will also consult with your doctors. Call 437-6902 to make a reservation for this review. Past participants have been very pleased!

MFALS

Nutritious lunches are offered Monday-Friday at the Senior Center, Fink's Café and Home Delivered Meals, for people 60+. "The suggested minimum donation is \$4.00. Please contribute the amount you can afford." Anyone under 60 is asked to pay the full cost of the meal which is \$8.97 for congregate and \$9.46 for home delivered. Congregate meals at the Senior Center are served at 11:15 am on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Please call to make reservations or cancellations at 437-6902 by 12:00 pm the day before. Wednesday meals are served at Fink's Café from 9:00 am -1:00 pm (no RSVP.)

LOAN CLOSET

Durable medical equipment is available for loan at no cost. We have wheelchairs, walkers, bath benches, commodes, canes, raised toilet seats, etc. Please check with the Senior Center before purchasing adaptive equipment.

RSVP

For Driver Escort rides to Appointments for doctors, dentist, eye, etc., Please contact Patsy Byrnes at 608-437-2518. Persons must be 60+ or older and must be able to transfer on their own into the vehicle. A three day notice is requested.

Seniors who are on Medicaid (MA) cannot use RSVP transportation. They would need to call MTM at 1-866-907-1493.

MILLER AND SONS

Seniors are welcome to order groceries from Miller and Sons on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday by 12:00 pm. Please call 437-3081 to order. The groceries are then delivered within Mount Horeb on Thursday. There is a \$15.00 minimum order.

Miller and Sons also donates food to the Senior Center on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays at 10:00 am! The number system is used.



NUTRITION, WELLNESS, PROGRAMS, SUPPORT, & SERVICES:

CARE VAN SERVICE

This service provides rides for Senior Citizens in the Mt. Horeb area. Transportation to meal sites and shopping is by donation. The suggested donation to the meal site is \$1.00/trip, the suggested donation for local grocery shopping is \$2.00/trip and the suggested donation for out of town shopping is \$3.00/trip. No one will be denied rides for these purposes based on their ability to pay. Please call Kristi at 437-8989 to make a reservation for a ride.

THE LITTLE FREE PANTRY

The Little Free Pantry is now available to provide nonperishable food and other necessities in and near the Mt Horeb Area. The three outdoor Pantries are available 24 hours a day and can be found at New Hope Evangelical Free Church (639 S. 8th Street); Immanuel Lutheran Church (310 West Main Street); and Zwingli UCC (1693 Washington Street, also known as Hwy 92) in Mt. LOCAL FOOD PANTRIES


