## JUNE EVENTS

All Programs and Activities will continue to be canceled until further notice. Case Management Services will continue through phone calls and emails. Home-delivered meals will continue on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

FYI: Foot Clinics that were scheduled for April, May and June are being tentatively scheduled for June 23rd, 24th, 25th and 26th. Safety and sanitation procedures will be taken.

Our Carry-Out Meals from Finks Café will now be offered on Tuesday and Thursday from 11:00 am-1:00 pm for curbside pick-up. People 60+ are eligible for the meal. There is a minimum suggested donation of \$4.00/meal. A "Special" will be offered each day and only one meal per/ person. Please call to reserve a meal at 437-8922.

Many people are experiencing "Social Isolation" during the pandemic and are longing for social connections. Social isolation and loneliness can lead to serious mental or physical health problems. Reaching out to family, friends or neighbors through phone calls or online visits, games, exercise, music, etc. are beneficial. "Well-Connected" is a FREE program where seniors can use their phone to call an 800 number and talk to people with common interests. Each session has about 12 participants on a call and they last about 30 minutes. If you have a cell phone, check with your phone plan, so you don't get charged for extra minutes. ### **NUTRITION MANAGER'S NOTE:**

Due to COVID-19, distribution of Farmer's Market Vouchers will be predominantly through the mail. The Area Agency of Dane County offers vouchers to seniors in Dane County to use in purchasing \$25.00 worth of fruit, vegetables or herbs at Farmer's Markets and roadside stands in WI from June through October 2020. The vouchers are distributed to people 60+ who have gross incomes under \$23,606/year or (\$1,968/month) for a one person or \$31,894 (or \$2,658/month) for two people. There is one set of vouchers per household. Past participants will receive an application in the mail along with the instructions for this year's program. For those who have never participated and wish to apply, contact AAA Dietician Alyce Miller at 261-5678. Vouchers may not be mailed until June 1.

# **DIRECTOR'S NOTE:**

Per GWAAR (Greater Wisconsin Agency on Aging Resources, Inc.) the IRS stated that the Stimulus Payment of \$1,200.00/person should be returned to the IRS if a person passed away before the money was received. Return the entire payment unless the payment was made to joint filers and one spouse had not died before the receipt of payment, in which case, you only need to return the portion of the payment made on account of the decedent. This amount will be \$1,200.00 unless adjusted gross income exceeded \$150,000.00. If the payment came as a check, write void in the endorsement section on the back of the check and mail the voided check. If it came as a check and it was cashed or it was direct deposited, you can send a check or money order payable to the U.S. Treasury and include 2020 EIP and person's Social Security number on check. Include a note stating reason for return. Send to: Fresno Refund Inquiry Unit, 5045 E. Butler Avenue, Fresno CA 93888. (Don't staple, bend or paper clip the check..)

# **CASE MANAGER'S NOTE:**

BEWARE OF PHONE SCAMS! Social Security is warning folks that telephone scammers are pretending to be government employees. They may threaten you and may demand immediate payment to avoid arrest or other legal action! If you receive such a call: HANG UP, DO NOT GIVE THEM ANY MONEY OR PERSONAL INFORMATION AND REPORT THE SCAM AT OIG.SSA.GOV. Here are some things to watch for; a caller says there is a problem with your Social Security number or account, any call asking you to pay a fine or debt with retail gift cards, cash, wire transfers or prepaid debit cards and emails that may look like official government papers or caller ID's with official looking numbers. Protect yourself! Contact the authorities, your family or Senior Center if you think you have been scammed!


# THE LITTLE FREE PANTRY


