Making great upgrades with Fiber Optic!

MHTC will be upgrading its main communications facilities in your area with new fiber optic cable. The new cable facility will support the latest broadband services including Internet, TV and Voice service. Work is scheduled to begin in Soon.

This cable upgrade is being provided to existing MHTC customers at no charge. If you currently use a different service provider, MHTC is giving you the opportunity to have a fiber optic line buried to your location without charge.

This is a one-time offer while the construction crews are placing the new cable facility in your area.

Mainline cable will be placed by plowing and directional boring methods to minimize digging and disruption of lawns and landscaping. Buried service lines to homes will for the most part be placed with a small drop "plow" which cuts a narrow slit in the sod to allow service cable placement at 12"-15" soil depth. Where trees, gardens, and other obstacles prevent standard cable

plowing, the directional boring process will be used. Minor digging will occur at existing service pedestal locations to accommodate

the new fiber optic cable. You may also see preliminary activity near your home as existing buried utilities are flagged and as MHTC personnel and cable crews prepare for the fiber optic cable placement and splicing
