<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We pay a lot of \$ for faster internet and they say, 'we will get 15' and when they test it, '8 is acceptable and meets our contract.' Not really truthful.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> They try (cust svc). Use 2 providers because we work remotely
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Using cellular data as TDS quoted \$75/month for DSL & had nothing better to offer. Cell signal is weak even though I'm on a ridgetop.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I pay over \$100 for internet and a basic landline. 15 Mbps is the fastest speed offered and it goes down frequently. I am very dissatisfied with TDS in general.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We need fiber optic for the <u>whole</u> township. It's not fair to drive by <u>blocks</u> (rural) from my home and see other DU's get better service. We all live in the same town! Apply for grants, please!

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We don't use internet very often.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Don't have any & won't get any!
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I see TDS constantly at the corner of Hwy 39 and Drammen Valley working on something. We have not had good internet in over 3 years from them. We have to use 5G as wifi - doesn't work.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are in what MHTC calls a pocket - they said, "there weren't enough houses to make it worthwhile." High speed comes down the road on both sides within 1/2 mile but they won't connect us.
