Minutes of Annual Meeting of the Electors
Perry Town Hall
Tuesday, April 15, 2025

1. Call to order. Call to order. Chairman Roger Kittleson called the meeting to order at 7:32 PM. Supervisors Ken Hefty and Mick Klein Kennedy, Clerk Mary Price and Treasurer/Deputy Clerk Stephanie Zwettler were present. Also in attendance: Larry Price, Mark Eastman, Michele Kittleson, Jan Eastman and Doug King and Margie King via teleconference.

Chairman Roger Kittleson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Minutes of the Prior Annual Meeting – April 16, 2024. Mark Eastman moved and Larry Price seconded a motion to approve the minutes of the Annual Town Meeting held on April 16, 2024 as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

3. Review Financial Report for the year ending Dec. 31, 2024. Clerk Mary Price presented the financial report for the year ending Dec. 31, 2024 and answered questions. Jan Eastman moved and Mark Eastman seconded a motion to accept the 2024 Annual Report. Motion carried unanimously.

4. Annual Reports – Committees, special projects, updates, etc.

Doug King, Parks and Open Space Committee chair, reviewed 2024 committee events and activities: Hauge Park astronomy class visits, declared an International Pollinator Pathway, security camera installed, additional signs installed, benches completed by Mt. Horeb High School class, Heritage Circle solicitations, Conservation Easement and Plan, DNR grant application submitted for gravel parking area, new committee member Nina Moyer Fink added.

Mark Eastman presented the annual report submitted by Mary Ann Nelson, Senior Center representative: serving 23 seniors in the Town with meals and other services, financial support from Dane County, Town, Village of Mt. Horeb, classes and other services offered, bus trips, provide medical equipment on loan, etc.

5. Comprehensive Plan amendment process and survey. Ken Hefty and Stephanie Zwettler explained the Comprehensive Plan amendment process. The Land Use committee will discuss proposed amendments compiled from the Town survey.

6. Friends of the Parks of Perry report. Mick Klein Kennedy, Friends of the Parks of Perry president distributed the Friends' 2025 newsletter, announced the Friends annual meeting will be June 15, 2025; Daleyville Park equipment will be installed in 2025; more grant opportunities will be reviewed; paver fundraising continues.
7. Hauge Historic District Park updates. Supervisor Mick Klein Kennedy reported the Historic Marker approved by the WI Historical Society will be installed; the gravel parking area, funded with a DNR grant, will be completed; annual monitoring by Groundswell will be completed on April 30.
8. Town Hall Restoration project. Mick Klein Kennedy reviewed the committee's work; testimonial letter presented to Premier Builders, Inc.
9. Any other business lawfully presented per WI § 60.11. None presented.
10. Adjourn. Jan Eastman moved and Mark Eastman seconded a motion to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 8:13 PM.
