Minutes of Annual Meeting of the Electors  
Perry Town Hall  
Tuesday, April 21, 2026

1. Call to order. Chairman Roger Kittleson called the meeting to order at 7:32 PM. Supervisors Ken Hefty and Mick Klein Kennedy, Clerk Mary Price and Treasurer/Deputy Clerk Stephanie Zwettler were present. Also in attendance: Larry Price, Mark Eastman, Michele Kittleson and Jeff Anderson.

Chairman Roger Kittleson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Minutes of the Prior Annual Meeting – April 15, 2025. Mark Eastman moved and Larry Price seconded a motion to approve the minutes of the Annual Town Meeting held on April 15, 2025 as presented. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Review Financial Report for the year ending Dec. 31, 2025. Clerk Mary Price presented the financial report for the year ending Dec. 31, 2025 and answered questions. Mark Eastman moved and Michele Kittleson seconded a motion to accept the 2025 Annual Report. Motion carried unanimously.
4. Annual Reports – Committees, special projects, updates, etc.  
Mark Eastman, Mt. Horeb Joint Fire Department – Town representative, reported the Department's new ambulance has been delivered and will be put into service soon.  
Mark Eastman presented a report submitted by Mary Ann Nelson, SW Dane Co. Outreach – Town representative: 26 Town senior residents received meals and other services; additional services provided by the Senior Center include clinics, meals, activities, day trips, classes, etc. 50 volunteers currently assist the Senior Center staff.

5. Comprehensive Plan amendment process and survey.  
Stephanie Zwettler reported that the Land Use Committee is reviewing each element of the Comprehensive Plan to develop proposed amendments by year end.
6. Friends of the Parks of Perry report. Mick Klein Kennedy, Friends of the Parks of Perry president presented the next issue of the Friends' newsletter and Hauge Park brochure; announced the Friends annual meeting to be held June 20, 2026 at the Hauge Historic District Park; Daleyville Park equipment will be installed in 2025; more grant opportunities will be reviewed; paver fundraising continues; Mt. Horeb High School trade class will produce a commemorative bench in memory of Brad Grundahl.
7. Hauge Historic District Park updates. Supervisor Mick Klein Kennedy reported Groundswell Conservancy will conduct their annual easement review; discussions continue to engineer and improve the Hauge Parkway.
8. Town Hall Restoration project. Supervisor Mick Klein Kennedy displayed newly framed historic plat maps to be installed; and reported two sound boards will be installed and include historic photos.
9. Any other business lawfully presented per WI § 60.11. None presented.
10. Adjourn. Mark Eastman moved and Larry Price seconded a motion to adjourn the Annual Meeting. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 8:10PM.
