General Notice

The Town of Perry will receive and accept bids ONLY through QuestCDN.com via the online electronic bid service (Quest vBid) for the construction of Town of Perry Driveway until August 20, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. All bids will be downloaded and publicly read aloud during a virtual public bid opening that will be held at the day and time of the bid closing. All plan holders will receive information via Quest on how to join the virtual meeting prior to the bid opening.

The Project includes the following Work: 835 LF of base aggregate Town driveway reconstruction and widening along with a parking lot, removal of existing culverts, grading and excavation for ditch construction, traffic control, 1 ¼ and 3 inch base aggregate, concrete curb and gutter, expanded parking and turnaround area, storm culvert installation, construction of two stormwater biofiltration basins, riprap with fabric installation, salvaged topsoil placement, seeding, erosion matting, and other associated erosion control.

The anticipated substantial completion date is **10/09/2026** and final completion date is **10/16/2026**.

Quest CDN requires the bidding documents to be downloaded from the site in order to submit a bid in the Vbid system. The designated website will be updated periodically with addenda, lists of registered plan holders, reports, and other information relevant to submitting a Bid for the Project. All official notifications, addenda, and other Bidding Documents will be offered only through Quest CDN. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for Bidding Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than Quest CDN.

Instructions to Bidders.

No proposal will be accepted unless accompanied by Bid security made payable to Owner in an amount of 5% of Bidder's maximum Bid price and in the form of a certified check, or an electronic Bid Bond issued by a surety meeting the requirements of Paragraph 6.01 of the General Conditions. If after 15 days the bidder shall fail to do so, the certified check or bid bond shall be forfeited to the Owner as liquidated damages.

No bidder may withdraw their bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

The minimum wages to be paid on the project shall be in accordance with the wage rate scale established by local wage rates.

Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.
